In 2 years, Lucy has progressed from graduate consultant to leading a digital innovation programme for one of IBM's largest accounts. Lucy has grown the scope of the innovation portfolio with her client from a single stream, 'core' innovation hub, improving existing operating models, to a vehicle for digital transformation to secure her client's future in times of unprecedented change.

She has earned the right to lead regular innovation sessions with client senior leadership, advising the CEO and executive board on ways to discover new and adjacent revenue streams through innovative concepts, and on diversifying their offering using emerging technologies.

Beyond the strategic value of the work she leads, Lucy is also an inspiring digital leader to a growing number of consultants. In 12 months, the team Lucy manages has grown from 1 to 14, as Lucy's client continues to request increases in capacity as value delivered continues to increase.
