799% of respondents emphasised ChMC's role in elevating professional standards within the industry Year-on-year, the number of Chartered Management Consultants has increased by **64%** compared to last year, reflecting a significant **122%** growth over the past two years. According to a recent ChMC survey by the CMI, **99%** of respondents agreed that the accreditation indicates a proven track record in management consulting. Additionally, **97%** felt it showcases integrity and ethical commitment, while **96%** believed it enhances their credibility with clients.



Of the **37** accredited firms, **30** are MCA members, highlighting the widespread adoption of ChMC within the MCA community. This milestone also includes **7** non-MCA firms, demonstrating the broad appeal and impact of ChMC across the consultancy landscape.

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
